1. how improve representation of artisanal fishers in the consultation and decision taking processes;
2. issues to be considered in establishing a differentiated management regime for artisanal fisheries, including safeguard measures viz a viz tradable rights (ITQs etc);
3. criteria for defining sustainable fishing practices, including social, economic and environmental aspects; and
