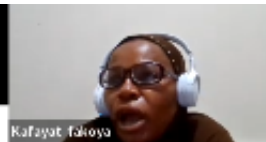

TYPES OF ADVOCACY ACTIVITIES

Technical and Legal Expertise

- Advocate for or against specific legislation, regulatory efforts, meeting politicians, questions in parliament, participating in various consultative processes, running public forums etc.



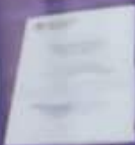
